We look forward to seeing you at The Grounds for a fantastic event. Please note that we do not reserve parking for event guests and any spaces on site are strictly reserved for patrons of The Cafe, Garden and Potting Shed, so we've mapped out some alternate transport options to make your trip as easy as possible!

By Walking

The Grounds is within 1-20 minutes walk from buses and train stations and we've mapped out the most direct routes on the map.

By Taxi

Taxis from anywhere in Sydney will transport you to The Grounds. Either tell the driver that you're going to The Grounds of Alexandria or give them our address of 2 Huntley Street, Alexandria.

By Public Bus

The 348 bus service between Wolli Creek and Bondi Junction stops on Huntley Street, directly outside The Grounds. Buses on this route operate frequently from 5:50am until 10:50pm, Monday to Friday and from 7:25am until 8:49pm on weekends.

The 305 service between Mascot and Redfern also stops nearby on Bourke Road and from there, it's just a short 2 minute walk to The Grounds. This bus operates regularly from 6:07am until 9:07am and from 2:40pm until 6:11pm, Monday to Friday.

By Train

Green Square Station is an easy 13 minute walk along Bourke Road and services the T8 Airport and South Line.

St Peters Station, servicing the T3 Bankstown line is also closeby and connects with the 348 public bus service between Wolli Creek and Bondi Junction. Alternatively, you may prefer to stretch your legs with a walk down Sydney Park Road onto Huntley Street.

If you're traveling on other train lines, please change at Central for interconnecting services to Green Square or St Peters Stations.

By Car

Onsite parking is strictly limited and reserved for Cafe and Potting Shed patrons only. Unfortunately there is no parking on site for event patrons.

Alexandria offers all-day and timed street parking options, just be sure to obey all of the parking signs.
